INFORMATION ABOUT TRØNDELAGSUTSTILLINGEN

Deadline for application is March 6th at 3 p.m.

Trøndelagsutstillingen is a yearly regional exhibition of contemporary art, organized by Trøndelag Bildende Kunstnere (the artists' association) and administered by Trøndelag Senter for Samtidskunst (Trøndelag Centre for Contemporary Art).

The applications are juried over two rounds. Digital documentation is used for the first round of jurying, while the second round of jurying evaluates the original works of art.

The jurying takes place anonymously. The artists name must therefore not figure in the picture files.

The first round of jurying will take place 18th - 20th of March

The applicants will be notified of the result of the first round of jurying by e-mail during week 13/14.

The second round of jurying will take place 8th – 10th of May. Information about delivery of original works will be provided to applicants that are invited to the second round.

The jury consists of the artists Charlotte Rostad, Barbro M. Tiller and Gabriel Johann Kvendseth.

Exhibition dates:

- Trøndelag Senter for Samtidskunst, 25th of May - 4th of August
- Levanger Kunstforening, 5th of October - 27th of October

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

All artists / art students with a connection (born, living, studying) to Trøndelag (Sør-Trøndelag county and Nord-Trøndelag county) are welcome to apply.

Applications may include

- two-dimensional works, such as paintings, prints, textiles and photos
- three-dimensional works, such as sculptures, installations and objects
- audiovisual works, such as video art, performance art and sound art

All applicants should submit digital applications via the application portal at www.trondelagsutstillingen.no

Guidelines for submitted material

- You can apply with up to 3 works.

- The exhibition shall primarily display works produced during the previous two years.
- The works should not have been shown in Trondheim region previously.
- Art students may apply with works that have been shown at graduation exhibitions.

Documentation of works

- All photographs must be of high quality, with a min of 1MB and a max of 2MB and 300 dpi per picture, in format jpg.
- Label the pictures number_title_year.jpg, e.g. 1_sunset_2014.jpg, 2_sculpture_2016.jpg, 3_installation_2016.jpg et cetera.
- NB: Because the works are juried anonymously, your name must not figure in the picture files.
- Two-dimensional works should be documented with one digital picture per work.
- Three-dimensional works should be documented with one picture of the entire work and one detail picture (labelled with “detail” in addition to the title of the work, e.g. sunset_detail_2014.jpg)
- It is optional to include a short project description (as a word or pdf file) to specify further information about your work/project. This applies in particular to performances, installations, site-specific and conceptual works, as well as projects that are not yet realized.

Video

- Submit a digital application via the application portal at www.trondelagsutstillingen.no
- Video works should be documented by a video stills, labelled *stills_title_year.jpg*
- For long works of video art, sound art or performance, an extract of a maximum of 5 minutes can be displayed during the first round of jurying, in addition to including the entire work.
- The applicant must state the duration of the work and provide technical details (projector, monitor, loop, time etc.)
- You can upload your video to vimeo.com and provide a link to the video or use a file transfer service as wetransfer.com or send it by mail (DVD/USB stick) to Trøndelagsutstillingen, Fjordgata 11, 7010 Trondheim.
